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Title:	CQC Inspection Reports for Friarage Hospital and James Cook University Hospital received March 2013
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Purpose:	To inform the Board of the very positive reports from the CQC following the two recent inspection visits.
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Key issues / items for consideration in the report:	<p>The CQC made an unannounced visit to the Friarage Hospital on 27 February 2013 and visited JCUH on 5 March 2013. The standards inspected at FHN were i) Care and welfare of people who use services and ii) Safety, availability and suitability of equipment. The standards inspected at JCUH were i) Respecting and involving people who use services, ii) Consent to care and treatment and iii) Complaints. All standards at both hospitals were met.</p> <p>Feedback from the inspectors on the day of each of the visits highlighted the excellent care they had witnessed, the knowledge and professionalism of the staff and excellent feedback from patients on their experience in our care.</p>
