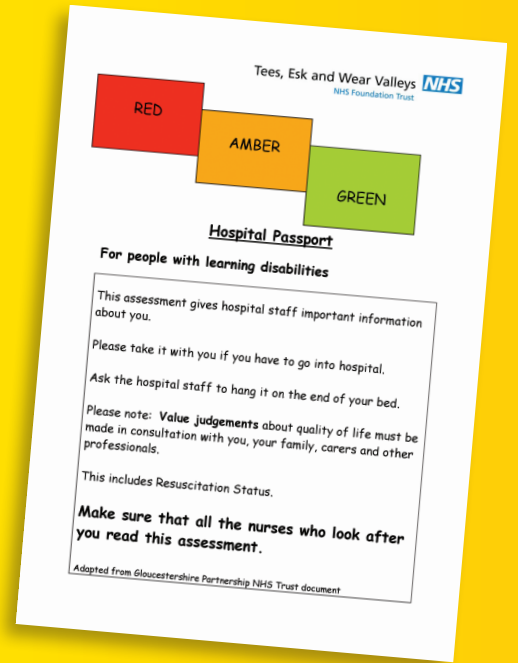


When caring for a patient with a learning disability have you ...

- Read their hospital passport.

- Made reasonable adjustments to support the needs of that individual, this could be by:
 - ensuring we have the right equipment to support someone
 - supporting a parent or carer to stay with a patient day and / or night
- Listened to their family / carer – the person that knows them best is not you.



- Ensured that discharge plans are being discussed with patient and family / carers.
