Do you know

• 30% of patients with long term physical health problems have mental health disorders compared with 9% of the general population.

- 46% of patients with mental health problem also have a physical health condition. The lifespan of people with severe mental illness (SMI) is shorter compared to the general population.
- Care is often is fragmented leading to poor outcomes and patient experience.

Don't let this happen to your patient:

- South Tees is committed to 'TREAT AS ONE'; addressing culture, process and education to ensure improved care for these patient groups.
- Well done! Patient experience reports tell us our patients with mental health disorder are treated with kindness and compassion but we need to more in order to make continued improvements.
